IMO STATE OF NIGERIA LAW NO. 12 OF 2020

A Law to Review the 2020 Imo State of Nigeria Appropriation Law (Law No.43 of 2019) to appropriate the sum of N95,347,637,782.00 (Ninety Five Billion, Three Hundred and Forty Seven Million, Six Hundred and Thirty Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred and Eighty Two Naira) only to the services of the Government of Imo State of Nigeria for the year ending on 31st day of December, 2020. This includes the Consolidated Revenue Fund Charges of N13,038,198,348.00 (Thirteen Billion, Thirty Eight Million, One Hundred and Ninety Eight Thousand, Three Hundred and Forty Eight Naira) only, hence a total Budget of N108,385,836,130.00 (One Hundred and Eight Billion, Three Hundred and Eighty Five Million, Eight Hundred and Thirty Six Thousand, One Hundred and Thirty Naira) only.

WHEREAS -

Preamble

By the 2020 Imo State of Nigeria Appropriation Law (No.43 of 2019), sums not exceeding the aggregate of N197,792,643,267.00 (One Hundred and Ninety Seven Billion, Seven Hundred and Ninety Two Million, Six Hundred and Forty Three Thousand, Two Hundred and Sixty Seven Naira) only was appropriated to the services of Imo State of Nigeria for the year ending 31st day of December, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE -

It is deemed necessary that the total aggregate sum stated above in Law No.43 of 2019 be reviewed downwards to N108,385,836,130.00 (One Hundred and Eight Billion, Three Hundred and Eighty Five Million, Eight Hundred and Thirty Six Thousand, One Hundred and Thirty Naira) only.

This is consequent upon the prevailing global health issue known as the COVID 19 Pandemic which has shut down virtually all economies of the world, affected international trade and global oil price upon which the 2020 Budget of Nigeria and that of Imo State were predicated.

The reviewed sums are as set out in the Schedules to this Law.

BE IT ENACTED by the House of Assembly of Imo State of Nigeria as follows –

Enactment

 This Law may be cited as the 2020 Imo State of Nigeria Appropriation (Review) Law. Citation

2. The Accountant-General may, when authorized to do so by Warrants signed by the Governor of Imo State of Nigeria, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Imo State of Nigeria during the year ending 31st December, 2020 the sums specified by the Warrants not exceeding in the aggregate, N50,381,537,911 (Fifty Billion, Three Hundred and Eighty One Million, Five Hundred and Thirty Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eleven Naira) only.

Issue of N50.381.537.911

3 The sums mentioned in Sections 2 and 3 shall be appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure as indicated in the First Schedule to this Law. Appropriation of N50,381,537,911

4. The Accountant-General may, when authorized to do so by Warrants signed by the Governor of Imo State of Nigeria, transfer from the Consolidated Revenue Fund during the year ending on 31st December, 2020 the sums specified by the Warrants not exceeding in the aggregate N27,525,099,871.00 (Twenty Seven Billion, Five Hundred and Twenty Five Million, Ninety Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred and Seventy One Naira) only.

Transfer from the Consolidated * Revenue Fund to Capital Development Fund of N27,525,099,871

5. The Accountant-General may, when authorized to do so by Warrants signed by the Governor of Imo State of Nigeria, pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Imo State of Nigeria, during the year on 31st of December, 2020 the sums specified by the Warrants not exceeding in the aggregate Expenditure of N44,966,099,871
